

COLORADO EMERGENCY REPORTING NET SHORT SCRIPT (Script Revised 03/29/2023)

PRELIMINARY ANNOUNCEMENT: “This is (Insert your call sign) announcing the Colorado Emergency Reporting Net will air in five minutes at 6:30 pm. This is a short, directed net where everyone is welcome to check-in. Prior to the net opening for general check-ins, at this time I am taking early check-ins from CERN volunteer monitors and Board members of the Colorado Connection. All Monitors and Board Members, if you have business for the net please indicate so when checking in.”

RESET and then call on any traffic for the net (if indicated)

(6:30:00 pm) OPENING THE NET “Good evening. This is the Colorado Emergency Reporting Net in conjunction with the Colorado Connection Repeaters INC. meeting every evening at 6:30 pm for 15 minutes. We practice copying information needed to report an emergency to 9-1-1 – and we provide the organization for licensed amateur radio operators to monitor Colorado Connection’s State-wide frequencies to answer any call for help. If there are any stations needing to break in for emergency traffic; Please say break and your call sign and we will suspend the net until your traffic is resolved. My name is (Insert your name and call sign in phonetics), and I am this evening’s host.

RESET.

(6:30:35 pm) GENERAL CHECK-INS “This frequency is now open to General Check-ins. Please say your call sign slowly, in ITU phonetics, and give your name and location. After three callers have checked-in, I’ll pause to verify call signs, names, locations, give a readability report, and I’ll ask if I copied your information correctly. This is the Colorado Emergency Reporting Net inviting anyone anywhere to check-in just for the count. Please call now.”

“KE0GSI, Frank, in Denver. I’m receiving you 4/5. Did I copy your information correctly?” (Yes) Thank-you.”
